April 17, 1944 - November 22, 2019

Carl Otto Peil, much loved father and grandfather passed away on Friday, November 22, 2019 at Bickford of Saginaw Township. The son of the late Godfrey and Lila Peil, Carl was born on April 17, 1944 in Bay City, Michigan. He married Margie Monroe on June 18, 1983, she predeceased him on November 15, 2012. Carl attended Central Michigan University earning a bachelor's degree in 1967 in Arts. He completed Electrical Apprenticeship School in 1972 and later attended Saginaw Valley State University earning a master's degree in Administration. Carl was a 50-year member of the IBEW as well as a member of the teacher's union for nearly 40-year.

He started his career working as an electrician for his brother before moving to work for Standard Electric. He then was offered the opportunity to become a teacher in 1972 at the Career Opportunity Center (now called Saginaw Career Complex) retiring from there after nearly 40 years of teaching. He continued working as an electrician after his retirement from teaching allowing him to work directly with his former students and family member which gave him great joy. Some of his many achievements over the years included the Apprentice of the Year Award and the Golden Apple Teachers Award. He was an educator and a story teller who shared his knowledge freely, inspiring and encouraging all, from his students to his children, grandchildren and extended family. He will lovingly be remembered for his faith in God, his love of his family, his memorable sayings and quotes and his sense of humor. He is survived by his 3 children, Andy (Karen) Peil, Saginaw; Amy (Frank) Brooks, Dublin, Ireland; and Matt (Cassie) Monroe, Kennesaw, Georgia; and by his grandchildren Corey, Daniel, Ewan, Finn, Joss and Evan. He is also survived by his two sisters and a brother, Janet King, Elaine (Gary) Voss, and Tim (Pat) Peil and many nieces, nephews and great nieces and nephews.

Honoring Mr. Peil's wishes cremation has taken place. Funeral Service will take place at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, December 2, 2019 at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church, 5250 Mackinaw Rd.
